


- The Annual Security Report covers a 3 year period
  - This year's report is for 2014, 2015, and 2016.
  - Clery crime statistics reporting is based on "Clery Geography" as defined by the Department of Education.
  - Reportable Clery Act crime statistics have remained relatively constant over the past year.
- Categories presented today are:
  - Crimes Against Persons
  - Crimes Against Property
  - Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)
  - Weapons and Drug Offenses



# Crimes Against Persons


- No Murders were reported within our Clery Geography
- Robberies have remained constant at 3
- Sexual Assaults increased from 14 to 16
- Forcible fondling cases have increased from 1 to 3





### Crimes Against Property


- Motor Vehicle Thefts have decreased from 2 to 1
- Burglaries increased from 16 to 17
- Arsons increased from 1 to 2





### Violence Against Women Act Offenses


- Reports of stalking have increased from 8 to 9
- Reports of domestic violence have remained steady at 3
- Reports of dating violence have increased from 26 to 31





### Weapon Arrests and Conduct Referrals


- Student Conduct referrals for weapons decreased from 10 to 4
- Arrest for weapons decreased from 7 to 2





### Drug Arrests and Conduct Referrals


- Student Conduct referrals for drugs decreased from 282 to 218
- Drug related arrests have decreased from 72 to 51





### Alcohol Arrests and Conduct Referrals

- Student Conduct referrals for alcohol have decreased from 301 to 170
- Alcohol related arrests have increased from 22 to 26
