Major legislative issues affecting NIU:

- Higher education policy and funding
- Research policy and funding
- Immigration
- Tax reform



Example: Tax Reform

Advocacy focused on protecting provisions of law that make higher education more affordable and accessible.

Multi-pronged advocacy approach was effective in passage of a final bill that:

- Maintains the tax-free status of tuition waivers for graduate students.
- Preserves current deductions for interest on student loans.
- Retains the Lifelong Learning Credit.
- Retains the ability of universities to provide tax-free tuition assistance for employees and their dependents.



Student Engagement

Providing enriching opportunities for students is a priority for OFR.

- Mentorship of students seeking DC career opportunities
- Internship with OFR
- Support NIU programs in DC
- Bring policy expertise to campus



Faculty Engagement

Facilitating connections for faculty is a priority for OFR.
