Healthcare occupations projected to grow more than any other workforce sector over the next 10 years.

- 16% increase from 2020 to 2030.
- 2.6 million new jobs will be added in healthcare.
- In 2020, the median annual wage for **healthcare** practitioners and technical occupations was **\$69,870**.
- The median annual wage for <u>all occupations</u> was \$41,950.



Health Sciences PhD = 45 to 60 (Self-funded; Hybrid with F2F residency weekends)




Diversity, Equity and Inclusion
