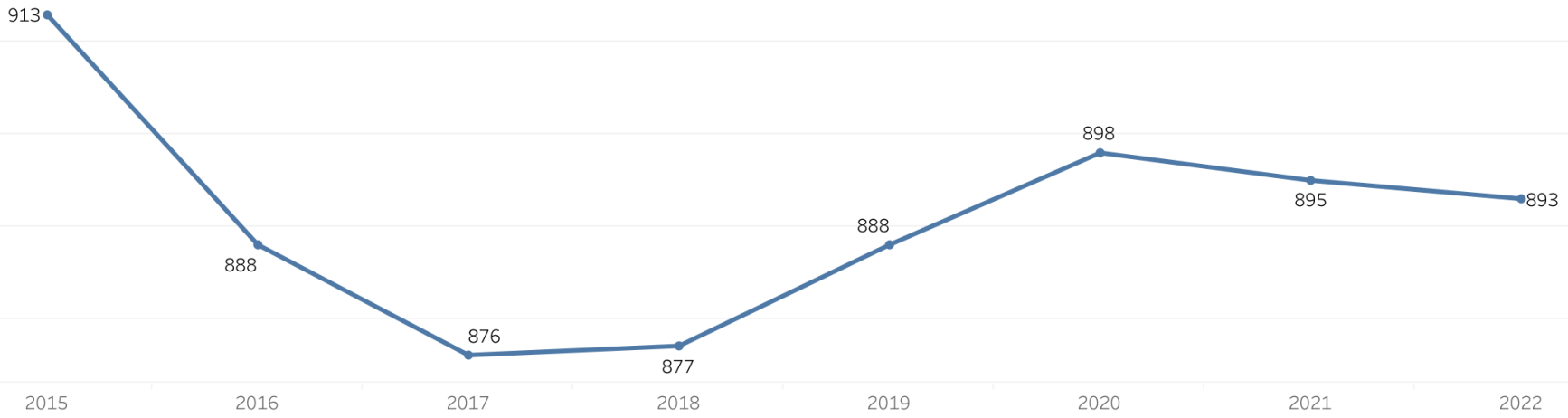
CVPA's strategic goals:

5. Eliminate equity gaps in student learning outcomes and D/F/W/U grades

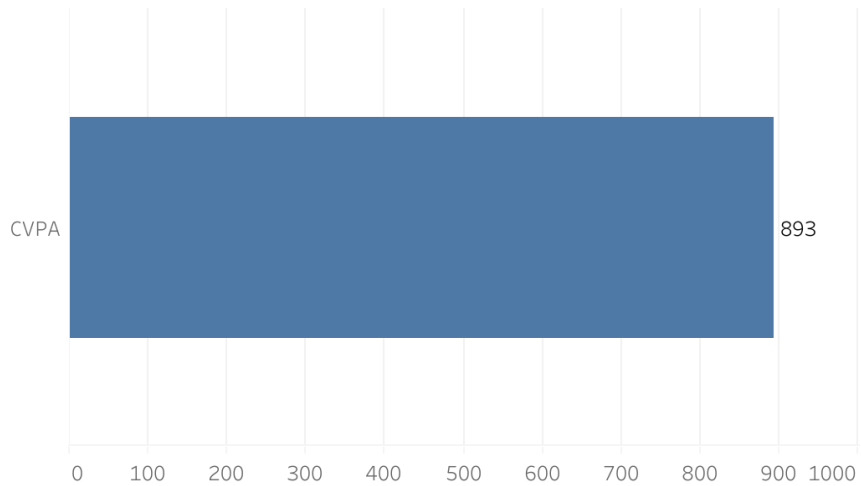
Enrollment and Retention



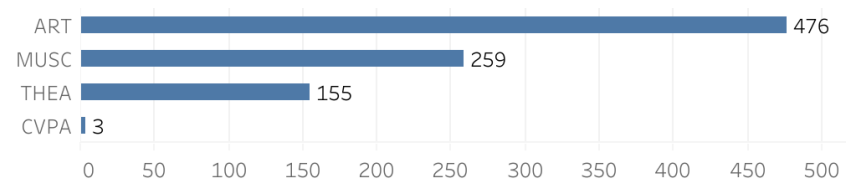
Total Enrollment Fall 2015 - Fall 2022

Enrollment by Department

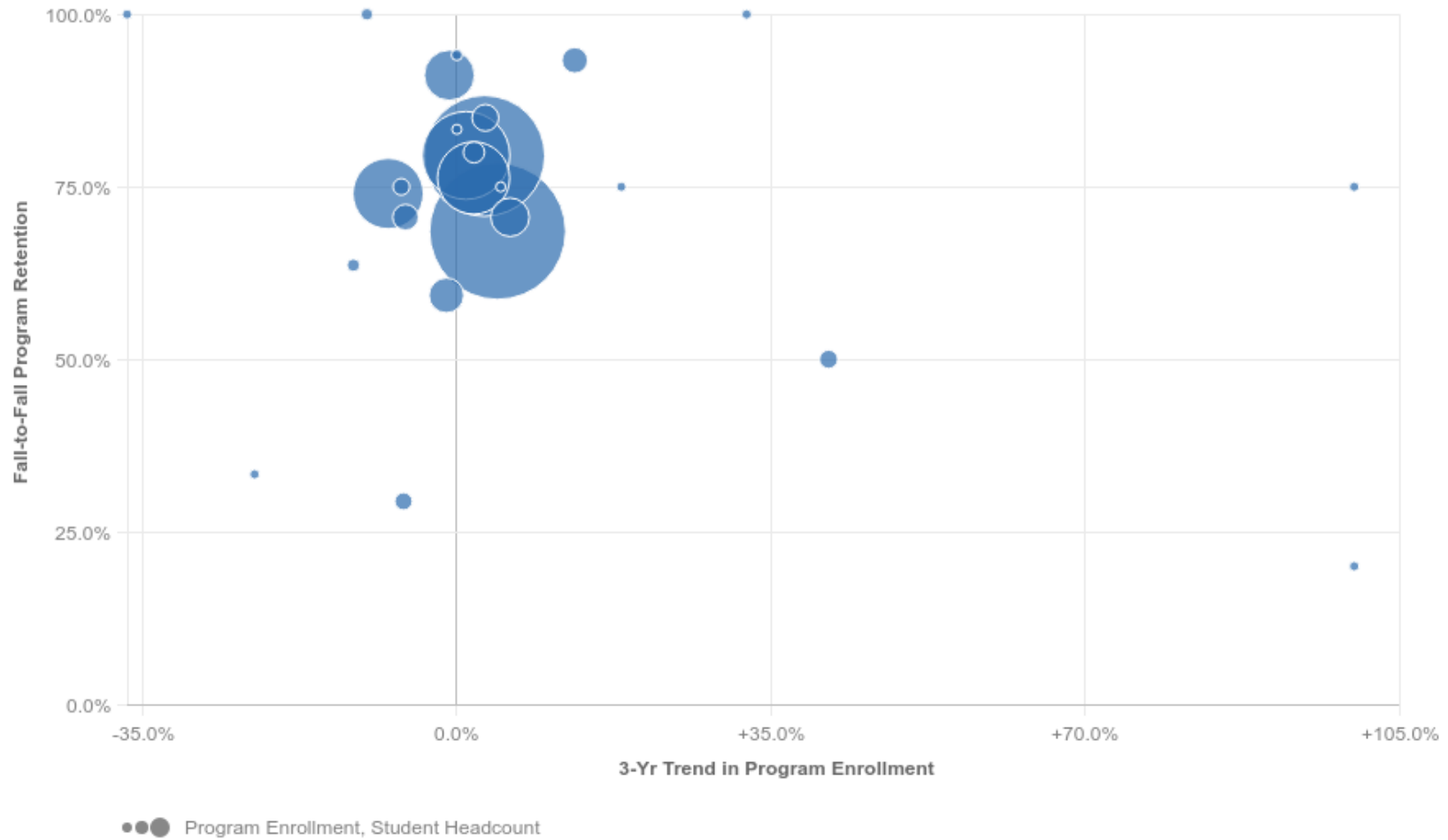

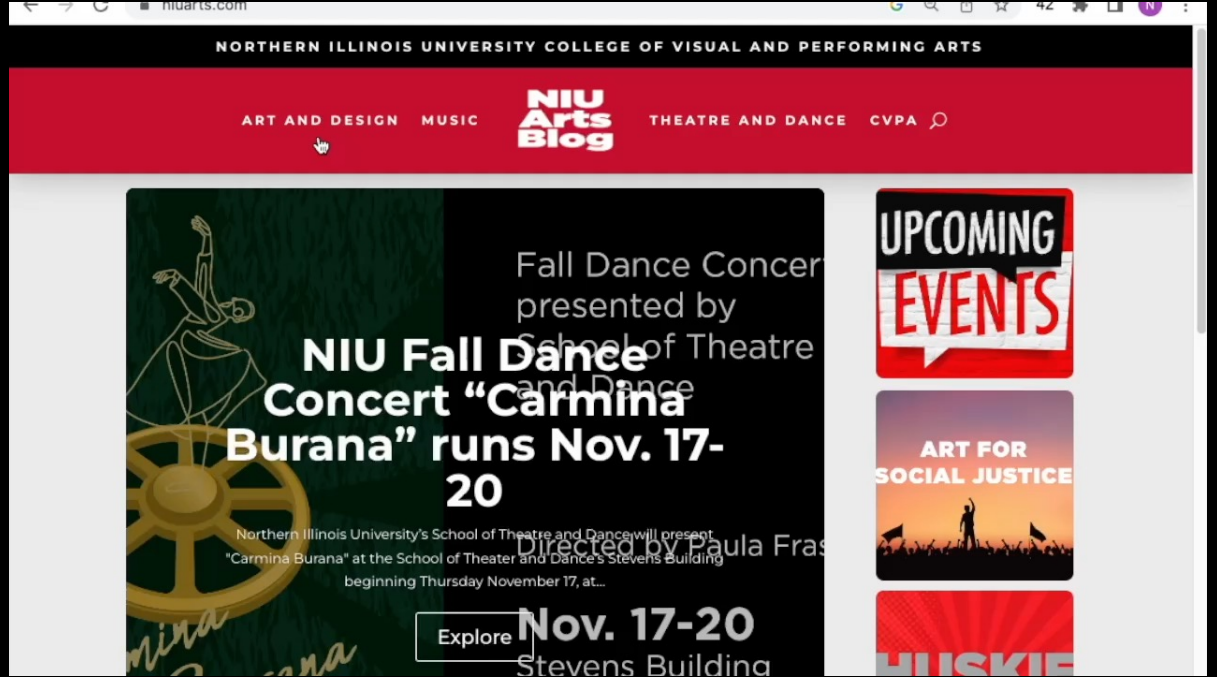

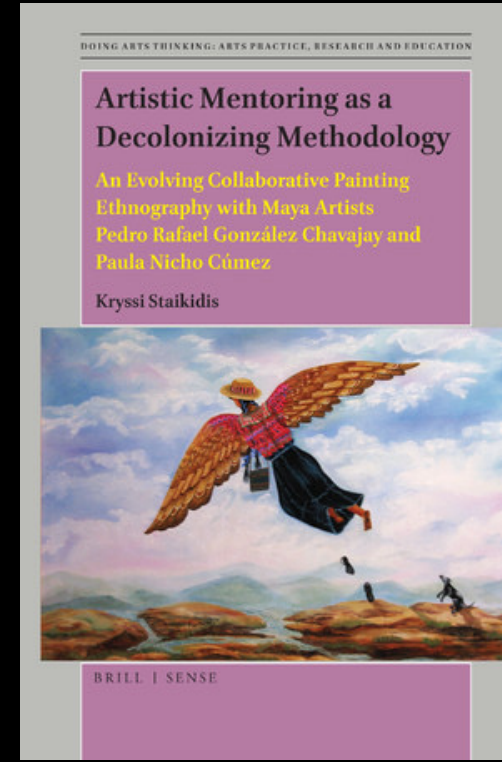
