NIU Points of Pride

Affordability

- NIU expanded eligibility for its state-funded, AIM HIGH Huskie Pledge program, assuring more freshmen will qualify for no tuition or general fee expenses.
- For 2023-24 fall/spring semesters, **64%** of new, full-time freshmen paid **\$0 out of pocket** for tuition and fees.
- **One of every three** Huskies who earned their undergraduate degrees in the summer of 2022, fall of 2023 and spring of 2023 graduated with **\$0** loan debt.
- **\$27.8 million** in NIU-funded scholarships was awarded to students during FY 2023, compared to \$15.8 million in FY 2018.

Recruitment and Retention for AY 2023-2024

- New transfer student enrollment increased by **6%**.
- NIU had its **third largest** freshman class in eight years.
- Our freshmen had an average high school GPA of **3.42** — tying the highest on record.
- Nearly **20%** of incoming freshmen had 4.0 high school GPAs, with each earning a **\$7,000** merit scholarship (and potentially **\$28,000** over four years).
- NIU had the **largest** fall-to-spring reenrollment rate for undergraduates in six years.

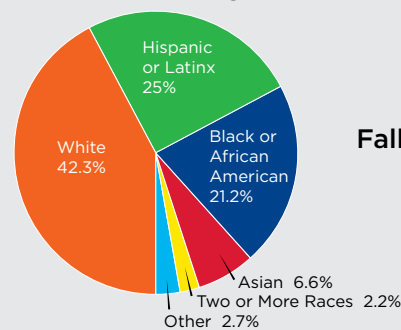
Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging

- NIU's libraries earned the 2024 Library Excellence in Access and Diversity (LEAD) Award from Insight Into Diversity magazine.

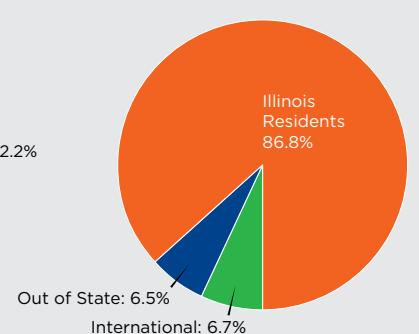
Research

- Non-COVID-19-related sponsored funding for research, instruction and other activities has grown by more than **87%** since 2018.
- NIU launched a new Research and Innovation website that, combined with university outreach, encourages collaboration with other universities, businesses and government: niu.edu/research-innovation.
- In the latest National Science Foundation (NSF) Higher Education Research and Development (HERD) survey, NIU ranks **third** among Illinois public institutions in engineering, physical sciences and social sciences.
- NIU's expansive new Edible Campus project has created a living laboratory that is producing experiential learning opportunities for students along with **thousands of pounds** of healthy food each year.
- A **\$1.5 million** modernization of engineering's Microelectronic Research and Development Lab is transforming the facility into a state-of-the-art fabrication lab dedicated to microchip research and design, workforce development and small-business innovation.
