

FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

May 3 – May 17

Morning exams begin at 9:00 a.m. and afternoon exams begin at 1:00 p.m. The number of hours for each final examination is normally equivalent to the number of credit hours for the course, but faculty have discretion to determine the number of hours allowed for their exams and may require a shorter or longer exam time. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of each exam. For afternoon exams, do not enter the exam room prior to 12:45 p.m.

You may request a change in exam date if there is a scheduling conflict in which two exams are scheduled on the same day or at least one exam is scheduled on each of three consecutive *calendar* days.
